### Members Call - March 7th

- Adoption of the 2023 CPA Action Plan.
- Presentation by David Hynes from ICAP and Olivier Lacroix from the Québec Ministry of the Environment, the Fight Against Climate Change, Wildlife and Parks, about Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) systems and Québec's implementation of its MRV system.

# 5. ADOPTION OF NEW GUIDELINES


- The CPA Secretariat undertook a review of the CPA governance guidelines to better reflect the current status of the partnership platform.


